

CURRENT COURT ATTENDANCE AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING REQUIREMENTS
FOR PUPILS

Pupils are required to:

- (a) actively assist in the preparation and conduct of:
 - i) at least 3 (three) civil trials, at least one of which must have been conducted in the High Court and one in the Magistrate's Court;
 - ii) at least 6 (six) criminal trials, at least two of which must have been conducted in the High Court and two in the Magistrate's Court and one must be a *pro deo* trial;
 - iii) at least 1 (one) civil appeal and 1 (one) criminal appeal;
- (b) actively assist in the settling of affidavits for and the preparation and presentation of argument in at least 4 (four) opposed applications of which 2 (two) must have been conducted in the High Court;
- (c) gain reasonable experience of unopposed High Court motion work and undefended divorce work;
- (d) actively assist in the preparation of pleadings, advices on evidence, memoranda and opinions;
- (e) sit in on consultations with clients and witnesses.
